PRIVACY POLICY

HOW DO WE COLLECT INFORMATION FROM YOU?

We obtain information about you that you give us in person, when you visit our website, when you use our car park and when you correspond with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise.

WHAT TYPE OF INFORMATION IS COLLECTED FROM YOU?

We collect the following information:

- your name;
- your contact information including your address, email address and telephone number;
- your vehicle registration number;
- when browsing our site, your IP address, your browser type and language;
- information regarding what pages are accessed and when;
- information related to your interest in Folkestone and the Seafront Development;
- information that you give us in person, when you visit our website and when you correspond with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise; and
- CCTV/Webcam footage for monitoring and security purposes.

HOW IS YOUR INFORMATION USED?

We may use your information to:

- provide information about Folkestone and the Seafront Development, our activities and services, and any other activities and services that we deem relevant or think you might find interesting;
- carry out our obligations arising from any agreements entered into between you and us;
- communicate with you;
- seek your views or comments on the Seafront Development;
- notify you of changes to the Seafront Development;
- deal with entries into a competition;
- administer car parking fees (Your payment card details are stored by Worldpay, along with your address. To keep information secure, Worldpay only gives us a token to charge your payment card);
- process a job application;
- administer our site and for internal operations, including troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research, statistical and survey purposes.
- keep our site safe and secure;
- comply with legal and regulatory obligations;
- enhance security and to check your identity.
